



Exposition Park Rules

To ensure everyone can enjoy Exposition Park safely, the following is not permitted:

- Driving over the maximum speed limit of 15 MPH.
- Disorderly, Disruptive, disrespectful, or degrading conduct or behavior
- Harassment or discrimination
- Damage, destruction, or theft of property
- Weapons, explosives, fireworks
- Possession or consumption of illegal or prohibited substances
- Smoking or vaping
- Public intoxication
- Skateboards, motorized bicycles, or off-highway vehicles
- Drones or other radio-controlled aircrafts
- Unpermitted loitering, tailgating, or camping
- Installations or temporary structures
- Gambling
- Littering
- Noise makers
- Dogs off leash

Guidelines are subject to change. Any violations deemed by Exposition Park staff or law enforcement are subject to removal from the park, citation, and/or arrest. Exposition Park is not responsible for any lost items or damage to vehicles or personal property.

Guest Code of Conduct and Behavior

We're more than an urban park with outdoor recreational activities. Exposition Park is a collection of world-class museums, educational and sport facilities, and entertainment venues. Within the 160-acre campus, you can experience the fun of science, math, and technology at the California Science Center, learn about the diverse cultural experience at the California African American Museum or explore natural and cultural worlds at the Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County, or simply relax in the splendor of the City of Los Angeles Rose Garden.

The landmark Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum offers the excitement of world-class competition, the Bank of Montreal/Los Angeles Football Club Stadium is the new cathedral of soccer, and EXPO Center is a hub of activity and resources for the whole community.

Exposition Park is committed to providing this space for all visitors. All visitors are responsible for their own conduct so that every person entering Exposition Park can expect a safe and comfortable environment in which they will be treated in a consistent, professional, and courteous manner. We thank you for your commitment and adherence to the following Guest

Code of Conduct

- 1) **Enjoyment and Respect:** Visitors are entitled to enjoy their experience free from disruptive or inconsiderate behaviors or unruly actions.
- 2) **Appropriate Language:** Visitors shall not use abusive, offensive, or obscene language and gestures whether spoken or appearing on apparel.
- 3) **Zero Tolerance for Violence:** Threats or acts of violence will not be tolerated. Visitors may not engage in fighting, taunting, throwing objects, or other behavior deemed detrimental to the experience of other guests.
- 4) **Commitment to Inclusivity and Safety:** Visitors must adhere to our code of conduct, which prohibits hate speech, discrimination, and any form of physical violence or intimidation against others on the basis of protected characteristics, such as but not limited to race, ethnicity, national origin, disability, religious affiliation, sexual orientation, sex, gender identity, age, or medical condition.
- 5) **Compliance with Staff:** Visitors shall comply with requests from staff and law enforcement officer regarding operational and emergency procedures.



Behavior

Exposition Park strongly encourages visitors to be reactive and report any concerns, harassing behavior, suspicious or disruptive activity to the nearest staff member or law enforcement officer.
